



# Scholarship Rules & Regulations

*As a contestant competing for a title in the Nationwide Pageantry system, I understand that the following rules and regulations apply to any scholarship funds which I am awarded as a result of winning or competing in any Nationwide Competition:*

1. Scholarships may only be used for educational expenses incurred at an accredited university, college, or technical school.
2. Scholarship funds may be used for tuition, room and board, and books necessary for a course.
3. Scholarship funds may be applied to outstanding student loan obligations.
4. Scholarship funds must be requested within TWO years of the date you competed in the Nationwide Competition.
5. *Scholarship funds not claimed within the designated time period will be forfeited and remain in the scholarship account for future awards.*
6. No cash settlement will be paid to any scholarship recipient.
7. In order to receive scholarship funds, contestant must submit an official copy of either:
  - (a) a billing statement from your respective school illustrating an outstanding balance,
  - (b) an official copy of a student loan statement from your loan provider illustrating an outstanding balance.

A cover letter requesting the funds must accompany the statement and should be sent to:

Scholarship funds will be paid directly to the school or student loan provider only.

Under NO circumstance will scholarship funds be paid to a contestant or any member of their family.

8. If you are disqualified for any reason or fail to complete your duties and responsibilities should you be named a Nationwide Pageantry titleholder, you understand and agree that any scholarship funds not paid to you will be forfeited.
